What Parents See in Edmodo (A Guide for Teachers)

Q: A teacher posts a note to the entire class. Does the parent see it or get notification?

A: No. The teacher must send to the parent group as well if they want the parents to see their post.

Q: A teacher posts a note directly to the student. Does the parent see it or get notification? A: Yes.* It is visible on the main parent page (Latest Posts) and also on the Activity tab of the student's profile page.

Q: A parent's child posts to the class. Does the parent get notification? A: No

Q: A classmate (not the parent's child) replies to a teacher's Note. Does the parent see it or get notification?

A: No- unless the teacher has made the post visible to parents.

Q: A parent's child replies to a teacher's post. Does the parent see it or get notification? A: If it is a private message between the teacher and student the parent will see the message and any replies. If it is in a group, the parent will not see it unless the teacher has made the original note visible to parents.

Q: A classmate (not the parent's child) replies to a posting by the parent's child. Does the parent see it or get notification?

A: No. Keep in mind this reply is on the group wall and is not private. Students cannot send private messages to one another in Edmodo

Q: A teacher posts a note to the entire class and includes the Parent group. When a classmate (not the parent's child) replies, does the parent see?

A: Yes. The replies inherit the permissions of the Note itself. Since the note is marked for Parents, the replies can also be seen by the Parents.
