**IMMUNIZATION INFORMATION 9-12<sup>th</sup>**

- Diphtheria Tetanus/Pertussis: At least 3 doses, with one since age 4
- Tdap/Td booster: 1 dose within last 10 years
- Polio: 3 doses, with one since age 4
- Measles: 2 doses of measles-containing vaccine after age 1, at least 30 days apart
- Mumps, Rubella: 1 dose of **each** after age 1
- Hepatitis B: 3 doses over no less than a 4-month period
- Varicella: 2 doses after age 1 OR history of chicken pox illness
- Meningococcal: 1 dose

*Test of immunity is acceptable in lieu of vaccine for measles, mumps, rubella, hepatitis B or varicella.*
