- Proof of Current Immunization-must be up to date
- Proof of Address: rental lease or current utility bill from the residence - a phone bill or driver's license is not proof of address - or a residency affidavit if the parent or guardian is living with a friend or family member.
- Last Report Card
- Social Security Card
- Birth Certificate

Returning students must have InfoSnap documents that show they have done their pre-registration online before coming on the designated schedule card pick-up days below.

IMMUNIZATION INFORMATION 7th & 8th grade

Diphtheria Tetanus/Pertussis: At least 3 doses, with one since age 4
Tdap/Td booster: **7th grade:** 1 dose if it has been 5 years since last dose of DTP
Tdap/TD booster: **8th grade:** 1 dose within last 10 years
Polio: 3 doses, with one since age 4
MMR: **7th grade:** 2 doses
Measles: **8th grade:** 2 doses of measles-containing vaccine after age 1, at least 30 days apart
Mumps, Rubella: **8th grade:** 1 dose of **each** after age 1
Hepatitis B: 3 doses over no less than a 4-month period
Varicella: 2 doses OR history of chicken pox illness
Meningococcal: 1 dose
Hepatitis A: **7th grade:** 2 doses
