ARLINGTON, Texas, Sept. 1, 2016 – The AISD Board of Trustees today announces assistant principals for Sam Houston High School and Adams and Speer elementaries.

Catina Henson has been selected as an assistant principal at Sam Houston High School. Henson has been an RTI specialist in the Fort Worth ISD since 2013. Prior to that, she was an assistant principal at Arlington High School from 2005 to 2013. Henson taught at Johnston Elementary in the Dallas ISD in 2005, and she was a health education teacher and coach at Lufkin High School in the Lufkin ISD from 1998 to 2004. She has a bachelor's from Sam Houston State University and a master's from Stephen F. Austin State University.

Nathan Tave has been selected as an assistant principal at Adams Elementary. Tave has been a sixth grade social studies teacher at Edison Middle School in the Dallas ISD since 2015. Prior to that, he was a third-grade teacher at Haley Elementary in the Irving ISD from 2013 to 2015. Tave was the dean of students and a social studies teacher at Hampton Preparatory from 2010 to 2013 and a social studies teacher and administrative intern at the Dallas Can Academy from 2005 to 2010. Tave worked in the Arlington ISD as an alternative ISS teacher at Blanton Elementary from 2003 to 2005, and he was a teacher and coach at Dunbar Middle School in the Fort Worth ISD from 2002 to 2003. Tave has two bachelor's degrees from Jarvis Christian College and a master's degree from Concordia University.

David Herrera has been selected as an assistant principal at Speer Elementary. Herrera has been a sixth-grade math teacher at River Trails Elementary in the Hurst-Euless-Bedford ISD since 2002.
